TNR Trapper and Transporter

Time Periods When Assistance Is Needed / Time Commitment:

We are looking for someone who can help trap and transport feral cat colonies to the vet for Spay/Neuter and vaccination appointments. This will be a role that will require 1-3 days of trapping and releasing per month to start. This will involve the full process of setting up traps, waiting, transportation to and from the vet, and re release.

Duties:

- Obtain traps from DAR board member
- Learn to set traps and be able to trap by yourself
- Ability to keep records and report them to DAR board
- Ability to drive cats to and from their appointments
- Be able to educate people that live around the colony and be able to relay directions

Qualifications:

- Must have a love for animals and a passion for making a difference!
- Positive attitude towards board members, veterinary staff and the community
- Good communication skills to ensure fosters can be found if necessary and appointments are not missed
- Good teamwork in working with other trappers and with coordinators
- Patience can be a virtue when waiting for a cat to walk into a trap!

Additional Information: Our TNR program is just over a year old and has been operating with 2 consistent trappers. We are ready to take things to the next step and be there in an even bigger way for our community cats, but we need more trappers.
