We are looking for someone who can help trap and transport feral cat colonies to the vet for Spay/Neuter and vaccination appointments. This will involve the full process of setting up traps, waiting, transportation to and from the vet, and re release.

Duties:

- Pick up and keep track of traps
- Learn to set traps and be able to trap by yourself and remain on site
- Ability to keep records and report them to the team
- Ability to drive cats to and from their appointments
- Be able to educate people that live around the colony and be able to relay directions for a successful trap.

Qualifications:

- Must have a love for animals and a passion for making a difference!
- Willing to wait on cats to enter traps in different weather conditions
- Good communication skills.
- Patience can be a virtue when waiting for a cat to walk into a trap!

Additional Information: These community cats are not able to be handled and will require someone that is sympathetic and wanting to help cats even though we will never receive anything in return from them. They are usually fully feral and quite different from household cats.
